Monthly Financial Report

Purvis Gray Audit Reports

The Honorable Jeffrey R. Smith asked Mr. Ryan Tucker and Mr. Michael Sandstrum, Purvis Gray, to present the annual financial statements and operational audit to the Board. Both audits reports presented were "clean reports," presented as "strong, unmodified opinions." There were no questions.

E-Portal Progress Report

Ms. Carolyn Weber, Portal Program Manager, was recognized to present the November Portal Progress Report. She noted that the volumes were declining slightly, as is normal for this time of the year, but despite the trends November 30, 2021, showed the highest number of submissions of the year (100,070) second only to the number of submissions sent through the system in June 2021.

Service Desk Report

Ms. Gia Howell, Portal Service Desk Manager, provided the highlights of the service desk inquiries for the month of November. She did note that the calls were slightly low compared to the few previous months, but typical for this time of the year.

Mr. Melvin Cox, FCCC IT Director, informed the Board that the implementation of a new payment processor, Adyen, was going smoothly so far.

Website Redesign Update

He informed the Board that the teams discovered one more issue to overcome late last week, but, pending no further delays, expected the site to be ready to be "live" by the end of next week.
